Rules for the Festival:

- 1) **Only one entry per event per Institution** is permitted.
- 2) Registration forms are to be filled in **CAPITAL LETTERS ONLY**.
- 3) Filled Registration forms can be either handed over personally or mailed to ecofeststie@gmail.com
Kindly note that **NO WhatsApp entries will be entertained**.
- 4) Each student can participate in **ONLY ONE event ON EACH DAY**.
- 5) Participation fee per event is mentioned in the form and payable at the college office. **No refund is possible in case of cancellation thereafter**.
- 6) On the spot registrations **will not be permitted**.
- 7) Last date for sending in the registration forms is **12th November 2019**.
- 8) Participants should be present **half an hour prior** to the event.
- 9) The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- 10) School entries are open only to students of **standards V-X**. However please note that **DEBATES (AB BOL COMPETITION)** is **ONLY** open to **standards VIII - X**.
- 11) Topics for the different competitions are indicated separately **for schools and colleges in different colours**.
- 12) Topics and rules for the debate competition will be communicated to the contact email id given in the form **2 days prior to the event**.
- 13) Working models should be prepared from bio-degradable material prior to the competition and displayed and explained by **two students** on the day of the event.
- 14) **Props for the Street Play and Fashion Show** competitions are to be carried along by the participant. **Only LCD facility** will be made available at the venue.
- 15) Please note that **use of English and Hindi** are permitted **for the Street Plays, Ads and Rap** competitions.
- 16) Posters/charts should have a relevant caption and can make use of any material which would enhance the look of the chart. Charts will be provided by the college. **Charts will be disqualified if ideas are borrowed from the internet**. Use of mobile phone for any reference purposes **IS NOT** permitted during the competition.
- 17) Students should **not wear uniforms/identity cards** so that their school/college identity is not revealed.
- 18) **RESULTS** will be announced at the venue **at the end of each competition** and displayed **on the college website thereafter**.
